

Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza in Oxford County

This is an important communication regarding biosecurity and quarantine provisions on your poultry farm.

The Feather Board Command Centre (FBCC) was recently made aware of symptoms consistent with highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI) in a poultry flock in your area.

FBCC has been working with the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) and we can now confirm that HPAI has been identified on a farm within an approximate 10km radius from your farm. CLICK HERE to access the 10km buffered biosecurity advisory map. CFIA may be contacting you if they haven't already done so and will provide more details about what is expected.

CFIA Primary Control Zones

CFIA will establish a Primary Control Zone (PCZ), in the area where the disease has been identified. Use the following link to access CFIA's maps, which will be updated:
