

Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza in Wellington County

May 4, 2022

This is an important communication regarding biosecurity and quarantine provisions on your poultry farm.

The Feather Board Command Centre (FBCC) was made aware of an elevated mortality incident in a small poultry flock in your area.

FBCC has been working with the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) and we can now confirm that highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI) has been identified on a farm within an approximate 10km radius from your farm. CFIA Primary Control Zones

CFIA has established Primary Control Zones (PCZ), in the areas where the disease has been identified. The PCZ have been established to prevent the spread of highly pathogenic avian influenza. Use the following links to access CFIA's maps:
