

Infectious Laryngotracheitis (ILT) Biosecurity Advisory Stand Down - Oxford

The Feather Board Command Centre (FBCC) is announcing a Stand Down for the ILT Biosecurity Advisory issued March 7, 2002 for a 10km buffered road area in [Oxford County](#).

A small mixed poultry flock was diagnosed with Infectious Laryngotracheitis (ILT) virus on March 7, 2022. FBCC established a Biosecurity Advisory Area to control disease spread.

Thanks to the enhanced biosecurity efforts of farmers and service providers, the virus appears to have been contained.

While the ILT biosecurity advisory is no longer in place, **the [province wide heightened biosecurity protocols](#) announced by the FBCC on March 26, 2022 to control the spread of highly pathogenic avian influenza, remain in place.** Farmers are reminded that they should have appropriate biosecurity personal protective equipment (PPE) available for themselves, their employees and anyone entering their premise.
