On behalf of Ontario's four feather boards, the Feather Board Command Centre is announcing that the ILT Biosecurity Advisory Area established Dec. 2, 2020 in Havelock area of Peterborough county has now been lifted.

The Biosecurity Advisory is being lifted today as the outbreak is considered resolved. The small layer flock has all died due to the ILT virus or been culled to control the disease. Barn has been cleaned and disinfected under veterinary direction and is currently in fallow until spring.

Normal specified biosecurity standards can now be restored throughout the area.
