

Infected Laryngotracheitis (ILT) BIOSECURITY ADVISORY STAND DOWN Chelmsford, Greater Sudbury

On behalf of Ontario's four feather boards, the Feather Board Command Centre is announcing that the ILT Biosecurity Advisory issued Dec. 16, 2020 for an area west of Chelmsford in Greater Sudbury has now been lifted. Normal specified biosecurity standards can now be restored throughout the area.

The Biosecurity Advisory is being lifted today as the flock veterinarian reports that the health of the surviving birds has improved, and measures are being recommended to prevent future problems.
