

Infectious Laryngotracheitis (ILT) Biosecurity Advisory Stand Down – West Elgin

The Feather Board Command Centre (FBCC) is announcing a Stand Down for the ILT Biosecurity Advisory issued June 12, 2022, for a 10 km buffered road area in <u>West Elgin</u>.

A small poultry flock was diagnosed with Infectious Laryngotracheitis (ILT) virus on June 11, 2022. FBCC established a Biosecurity Advisory Area to control disease spread.

Thanks to the enhanced biosecurity efforts of farmers and service providers, the virus appears to have been contained.

All poultry farmers, small flock growers and poultry industry personnel throughout the province should rigorously adhere to <u>Routine Biosecurity levels (green cards)</u> as HPAI recovery efforts continue.
