

ILT BIOSECURITY ADVISORY STAND DOWN

Re: FARMER NOTIFICATION - ILT DISEASE ADVISORY November 29, 2017

On behalf of Ontario's four feather boards, the Feather Board Command Centre wishes to announce that the biosecurity ILT advisory that was issued to commercial poultry farmers and small flock growers in northeastern part of Oxford County on November 29, 2017 has now been lifted.

This Oxford County commercial table egg layer flock had been epidemiologically linked to a preceding case in a commercial layer pullet flock in Waterloo County. Re-vaccination has been effective in controlling both these incidents. Ongoing veterinary surveillance indicates no further signs of illness.

Normal biosecurity levels can be restored.

Farmers should continue to be very diligent in observing their flocks, monitoring mortalities and tracking feed and water consumption. If you suspect any signs of infectious disease, please contact your veterinarian and board immediately.
