On behalf of Ontario's four feather boards, the Feather Board Command Centre is announcing that the ILT Biosecurity Advisory Area established Sept 22, 2020 for Norwood Township in southeastern Peterborough County has now been lifted.

The disease incident at this registered small flock has been fully resolved. Normal specified biosecurity standards can now be restored throughout the area.
